

Newport Historical Society Museum Report for June 10, 2013

Since our last meeting (13) visitors have signed the attendance book.

We held a Chamber of Commerce “Business After Hours” on May 15, 2013. Thirty-two people dropped business cards into the “hat” for the drawing.

We purchased (2) oversized archival photograph binders and extra sleeves from Gaylords for \$350. We purchased (2) boxes of Velcro for \$40.

We have had (3) donations since the last meeting:

Ann Stout donated a copy of her Photograph book on the Offspring's of Greek Families in Newport.

The Corbin/Edgell family donated (43) items relating to the Corbin/Edgell & Champollion families. Among the items were (27) deeds dating from 1795 to 1831. (5) family scrap books, a photograph book on the animals in Corbin Park, a Croydon history, (3) books by Harold Baynes among the most interesting.

Stan Sweeney donated (12) items related to Sturm-Ruger (coffee mugs, pens & Christmas ornament) and Military (coffee mug, magnet & pin)

We have additional quotes to have the building re-roofed. We now have (6) quotes ranging from \$6,543.50 to \$14,850.00.
