- 1) I recently received an email from Joan Dodge who state that she plans to have the order for our two 2017 ornaments shipped to us this month.
- 2) The Corbin Bridge postcard supply has been replenished. We also now have the fall/south church postcard available. Ann Stout has informed us that she will not longer be ordering post cards for us from Vista Print. We are looking for a volunteer to do this once or twice a year.
- 3) We now have several owl photos to choose from and hopefully Rita, Stan and I will be making a decision for the post card and note cards in the next few weeks. The delay has been my fault as I wanted several photos for us to choose from.
- 4) The Farmers' Market began on May 19. There have been four markets to-date and we missed one due to showers. Sales have been slow but the visability is always strong and people stop to visit.
